

Château de Ruth stands in Sainte-Cécile-les-Vignes, located north-east of Orange in southern Rhone Valley. It is one of the oldest domain in the Rhone Valley, its name first appeared in 1561. Ruins of a convent built under King Louis XIV can be seen on the estate. In 2010 Vincent Moreau bought the beautiful property with the vineyard attached. He devotes all his know-how and enthusiasm to product quality wines from the exceptional terroir of red clays and river stones

Southern Rhone Valley 2020 vintage: The 2020 vintage is balanced despite heterogeneous yields between productive areas and areas more or less affected by climatic hazards. Overall, the vines have not suffered from drought and they reached maturity. The harvest took place under optimal conditions, particularly for southern white wines, which have attractive aromatic profiles.

GRAPES: Grenache 70%, Syrah 30%

AGE OF THE VINES: Between 10 and 30 years

VINE ORIENTATION: South

PRUNING: Cordon de Royat

YIELD: 35hl/h

SOIL: Clay-limestone

FARMING PRACTICE: Sustainable HEV certification level 3

WINEMAKING: Thermo-regulated tanks and pre-fermentation maceration

TASTING NOTES: This wine has an elegant red ruby color and nice fruity aromas. The nose is expressive with cherry and raspberry fragrances. On the palate, it's round and soft with black fruits flavors. Tannins are fine and elegant for a really charming wine.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING: Beef carpaccio, duck burger, gratin dauphinois, chicken barbecue, rabbit in cream sauce, cheese
