



CHÂTEAU SAINT-PREIGNAN

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2021



DESIGNATION: IGP Pays d'Oc

GRAPE: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

SOIL: Clay & Limestone

ABV: 12,5%

WINEMAKING: Total destemming followed by maceration for 15 to 20 days. Daily pumping over with tasting to assess the evolution of the structure and richness of the wine. Temperature control is decisive to keep the freshness of the wine

TASTING NOTES: Beautiful ruby color with purplish reflections, the nose is very expressive with notes of cocoa and tobacco. The mouth is dense and fleshy with a hint of liquorice

FOOD PAIRING: Perfect with spicy oriental food

ABOUT CHÂTEAU SAINT PREIGNAN: Château Saint-Preignan is a family property located in Pouzolles (Languedoc). 5th generation producer is taking care of the 100-hectare vineyard. Much of the estate was originally pond and swampland that was filled in. Now the vines go deep through schist to seek water in the blue clay.
